Letter from the Board Chair

For the last two years, I've had the privilege of serving as Chair for the Great Outdoors Foundation (GOF) Board of Directors. I was first drawn to GOF because of my love for nature and recreation, but I've stayed engaged because of the organization's commitment to its mission. It's the same reason you choose to support GOF — you know that when we say we're going to do something, we're going to deliver.

If you've been around long, you know that we sometimes, or maybe most times, take an unconventional approach to environmental strategy. Whether it's forming unlikely partnerships or using recreation to cultivate stewardship, our team, like you, remains steadfast in advancing conservation. I believe this is the secret sauce of our success.

During my tenure, we've achieved several notable accomplishments, thanks to all of you:

- Engaged dozens of stakeholders in a multi-faceted water quality task force.
- Secured \$22 million in state funding for ICON Water Trails.
- Increased our annual giving by 38%.

If you take the engagement, excitement, and expectation that has stirred around the Conservation Fund in the last year, and extrapolate it over the next decade, it becomes very apparent that this is our moment. The Conservation Fund allows us to safeguard them, while still supporting the vital business and industry that is the essence of our economy and community. It's a coalitionbuilding approach that brings all parties to the table, and propels us forward with optimism, rooted in proven tactics and outcome-driven solutions.

Getting to announce the Conservation Fund publicly at our Wild Prairie Showdown with so many of you in the room was incredibly special. It's a poignant reminder that everything we do is empowered by our many dedicated supporters — by you. Letter from the Development Department

As a fundraising organization, so often our successes are measured in dollars. That makes total sense, and from a progress standpoint, it makes growth easily quantifiable. For example, since 2021, our corporate investments have increased 57%, individual fundraising has increased 126%, and revenue from our Annual Golf Outing has increased 43%. These donations are what empower our organization to act as a leader in conservation and recreation initiatives.

But, beyond the funding we secure both operationally and for our partner projects, the impact of the Great Outdoors Foundation (GOF) can be measured in other, less conventional metrics. For example, feet of trails activated — more than 30,000, thanks to the Athene Pedestrian Bridge — or time spent on our waterways — upwards of 250,000 visits during a single season for ICON Water Trails. We could measure our performance in the smiles of those enjoying a day at the Jester Park Nature Center or in the health of our community that has access to greenspace because of the Polk County Water & Land Legacy Bond. What I'm getting at is that as important as the fundraising is, and it is important, our work and your investment will always be focused on the impact.

You've already learned about the Conservation Fund and its audacious goal of securing \$250 million for water quality improvement initiatives, but what does that funding really mean for you? For your community? For your state? Well, I can't read the future, but here's what we're working toward, with your support: clean water, sustainable business, protected resources. Once our portfolio of expertly-designed projects is implemented, we'll be measuring success in an entirely different way, both in quantifiable data and qualitative anecdotes.

Perhaps our greatest indicator of success will be when Iowa is used as a model for other states working to safeguard their own natural resources.

I think that milestone is closer than we realize.

Development Spotlight

Thanks to our partners at Athene, the Great Outdoors Foundation (GOF) invested \$100,000 from its Conservation Fund into an urban wetland in Ankeny, led by John Swanson, Water Resources Supervisor for Polk County Public Works. This private funding activated more than \$1.3 million in public dollars, equating to a 13:1 public-private match. The permanent infrastructure involved with this project will treat stormwater, reduce erosion, and create flood storage, ultimately managing more than 400 acres of untreated urban drainage for the next century and a half. In just this one example, you can see how the Conservation Fund acts as a multiplier, rapidly increasing the resources dedicated to water quality improvement initiatives. The Conservation Fund truly embodies the mission of GOF — to advance conservation through innovation, collaboration, and stewardship. With creative strategies, expert partners, and targeted investments, we can do more, faster.

Marketing Spotlight


